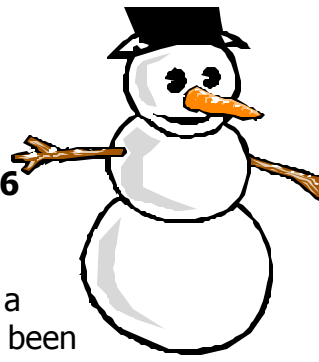


# LVHIMA PRESIDENT'S NEWSLETTER
